Chosen as one of the 50 great towns of the west..it is far from commonplace.

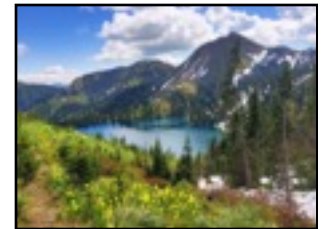
Elevation 2,968, Bigfork offers countless historical and cultural experiences

The largest natural freshwater lake west of the Mississippi is 28 miles long and up to 15 miles wide which translated to over 188 square miles of pure beauty and enjoyment. Surrounded by national Parks, forests and protected lands, the Flathead Valley is a gateway to the wilderness.
